<u>INNOVATION MINI-GRANT AWARD NOTICE – Early Childhood Mental Health</u> Evidence Informed Best Practice

** Edmund Moore moved that the Program and Services Committee recommend to the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board for Montgomery County receive \$32,000 from the Ohio Department of Mental Health and to disburse these dollars to Samaritan Behavioral Health, Inc. to produce a digitally based media segment that demonstrates innovative early childhood mental health evidence informed best practice that addresses priority populations.
