<u>Purpose</u>

To assure that current and potential providers certified by either Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services (ODADAS) or Ohio Department of Mental Health (ODMH) have access to a Medicaid contract with ADAMHS Board.

Policy

The ADAMHS Board for Montgomery County will adhere to the provisions of 42CFR 431.51 Free Choice of Providers. This means that a service provider in Montgomery County certified by ODMH or ODADAS or both that meets the information system reporting and financial documentation requirements established by these departments must be awarded a Medicaid agreement by the ADAMHS Board. In addition, the ADAMHS Board will provide the local matching funds to the provider(s).

Procedures

The ADAMHS Board requires current and prospective providers to:

- 1. Complete and have the Application for Funding to include fiscal pages approved by the ADAMHS Board for Montgomery County before issuance of a Medicaid contract.
- 2. Obtain a Unique Provider Identification (UPI) number.
- 3. Obtain a National Provider Identification (NPI) number.
- 4. Pass tier 1 and tier 2 tests for automated billing through MACSIS.
- 5. Submit user name and password to ADAMHS Board for access to the board FTP servers.
- 6. Submission of Medicaid rates to ODADAS and/or ODMH by provider.
- 7. Attend MACSIS training by ADAMHS Board staff.
- 8. Submission of Medicaid claims to ADAMHS Board by the provider.
- 9. Submission of Behavioral Health data to ADAMHS Board by provider.
- 10. Submission of Outcomes data as required to ADAMHS Board by provider.
